Large models or architectural renderings relied upon by the Applicant shall be available for viewing at the UEL Administration Building by **February 21, 2018**.

A copy of the correspondence and other materials already in the Assistant Deputy Minister's file shall be available for review by UEL residents including the Applicant or their Agent, upon request between **February 19 and February 26, 2018**, at the UEL Office Administration Building at 5495 Chancellor Boulevard.
