The University Endowment Lands (UEL) has launched an OCP Update. The existing OCP was adopted in 2005, and a lot has changed since then.

The OCP Update is your chance to share your ideas and help shape our community's future.

What We Heard - Engagement Round 1



Many community members want the community to grow and develop, to meet increasing needs.



Desire for more housing, with a mix of housing options, including more family-friendly homes, affordable housing, multigenerational housing, and opportunities for seniors to age in place.



Desire for a complete and livable community with more housing, services, amenities and commercial options.



Emphasized importance of maintaining, protecting, and connecting parks and greenspaces, and maintaining the tree canopy.



Interest in more amenities like gathering spaces, recreation facilities, community gardens and outdoor spaces, and commercial and service options like grocery stores and childcare centres.



Some community members prefer the community to remain unchanged.
