PART 1 – APPLICATION OF BYLAW

This Bylaw is made by Ministerial Order [NUMBER] pursuant to the *University Endowment Land Act* RBSC 1996 c 469 (the "UEL Act").

This Bylaw provides an alternative means of publishing a notice as authorized by section 12(1)(g.1) of the UEL Act.

This Bylaw applies to all notices required to be issued under section 12(5) of the UEL Act.

This Bylaw may be cited as the "UEL Public Notice Bylaw".

No provision of this Bylaw shall depend for its validity on any other provision of this or of any other bylaw, it being the intention that, notwithstanding that one or more of the provisions of this or of any other bylaw may be invalid, as many as possible of the provisions of this bylaw shall remain in force and effect, as though such invalid provision or provisions were never enacted.

PART 2 - PUBLICATION OF NOTICE

- 2.1 Notice required by section 12(5) of the UEL Act regarding the Minister's enactment of a proposed bylaw is provided by publishing it as an advertisement in online format in a newspaper distributed in the University Endowment Land at least once a week for two consecutive weeks.
- 2.2 The required form of notice under section 2.1 of this Bylaw must be posted not more than 60 days and not less than 30 days before an order of the Minister is signed to enact the bylaw.
- 2.3 Nothing in this Bylaw prohibits the Minister from publishing public notices in any other manner.
- **2.4** For certainty, the Minister is not required to publish the notice under section 2.1 of this Bylaw in a physical print newspaper format.
